## Small Grants Fund

Funded by the Young Peoples Facilities and Services Fund

Thank you for your interest in making an application to the Small Grants Fund. The aim of the Small Grants Fund is to make resources available to community or voluntary organizations including sports groups that enable them to divert 10-21 year olds from the dangers of substance misuse

Since 2000, the fund has provided over €400,000 in funding to more than 100 clubs, groups and organisations in Ballymun.

Grants can be used for basic programme/activity costs, tuition fees, transport costs, equipment, overhead costs and minor refurbishment. Note that school curricular activities will not be taken into consideration.

The maximum grant available for any one group is €2,500.

When making your application, please take note of the following:

- Please complete the form as thoroughly as possible, answering **ALL** questions. Please ensure that contact information is complete. Incomplete applications will **not** be considered.
- Grants will only be allocated for activities and/or equipment that are additional to general operating costs.
- Successful applicants may be requested to present receipts or proof of purchase to demonstrate how the grant was used.
- Only applications made on the application form will be considered.
- Applications must be submitted to The Reco \_\_\_\_\_.  
Late applications will not be considered.
